## The School

We are a 15 minute walk from the railway station and a 20 minute walk from all the amenities that Cambridge city centre has to offer.

### Doctor

The nearest GP surgery is Woodlands Surgery located on Station Road just a short walk from the Cookery School. 01223 697600

The school is on several bus routes into town. From the city centre - Emmanuel Street (next to Drummer Street Bus Station). Stop E1 for the Citi 1 or Citi 7 buses which stop directly opposite Hills Road Sixth Form College. This is the closest stop to CCS. Journey time approximately 11 minutes.

## Directions

### From the station

We are a 10/15 minute walk away on a safe and busy route. From the main exit follow Station Road straight ahead until you reach Hills Road. Turn left on to Hills Road, continue over the railway bridge to traffic lights at the junction with Cherry Hinton Road. You will see Cambridge Leisure on your left as you cross the bridge. Continue straight on through the lights until you reach Hills Road on your right and Coop on your left. Turn right into Purbeck Road. Continue down to the bottom of Purbeck Road, past the tennis courts on the left and then turn left in front of Abbey College into Homerton Gardens. You will find us approximately 30m straight ahead on the left.

### By Car

Turn into Purbeck Road off Hills Road by the Sixth Form Centre then follow the directions above. There is no parking on site. The nearest car park is at Cambridge Leisure.

### By Bike

Follow the above directions. There are cycle racks outside our building.
